VOTING IN THE AGE OF CHAOS

I. The Age of Chaos

Regardless to which political party you belong, we can all agree that these are strange times.

Food prices, gas prices, housing prices, unemployment, high taxes, open border crisis, fentanyl, indoctrination of children, loss of parental rights, uncertain reproductive rights, rampant crime, racism, the homeless, political uncertainty, devaluation of the dollar, plus Russia, China, Iran, and Anti-Semitism on the move has everyone frozen with fear.

To those in the chaos epicenter, California District CA 32, who plan to continue to simply vote along party lines - Brad Sherman, Democrat left or Larry Thompson, Republican right - should reconsider their plans, realize the world has changed forever, and recognize we are now living in the Age of Chaos and all traditional voting bets are off.

Meanwhile, technological disruption is enriching those who own and invest in these innovative technologies at a pace never seen before in human history.

"Even more troubling, thanks to the confluence of the three giant long-term trends, Navellier believes the next decade "will be a period of extreme change and social strife. It will be an era that will seem like madness to billions of people. We will exit this decade a different society than the one that entered it. We'll see historic transfers of wealth. People who are rich now will be penniless when the decade is over. People who are penniless now will possess huge fortunes. Industries and economies will boom and bust at rates that will make people's heads spin. Stock and bond prices will soar and crash at light speed.

"These three 'megatrends' are: Exponential technological progress, Mass debasement of the dollar, and Deglobalization.

"Any one of these trends is a huge change agent by itself. But together, they will bring total chaos to markets, politics, and society. People will feel deeply unsettled, confused, and worried."

All across America, hardworking citizens who learned their crafts during the 1990s and 2000s feel like they have entered a bizarre, nonsensical Franz Kafka labyrinth of exploded social movements and technology: AI, iPhones, YouTube, and Bitcoin. While we are trying to be inclusive, they are concerned they are going to be left out.

So, you see, the winner of the 2024 election will inherit many social and economic issues and to solve one he (or she) could exacerbate another and possibly trigger an economic and fiscal crisis the likes of which we have never seen before.

"Big Tech will censor millions of dissenting Americans after the election is called...Migration and crime rates will spread out from major cities, into suburban areas, making even safe neighborhoods look like the streets of San Francisco or downtown Los Angeles: Homelessness could spread to

manicured streets in areas that were once idyllic - with many of the homeless being elderly. Wokeism could become the dominant culture in America, instead of just a loud fringe group. Foreign aggressors could likely take over more of the globe, without the U.S. doing a thing about it...And the war on fossil fuels could be accelerated as the economy goes fully green and the cost of living soars...

"On the one hand, America is a place of extraordinary wealth... a place where billionaires travel in private jets and buy \$10 million condominiums with a month's pay. The system is working great for these people. On the other hand, America is a land of extreme poverty and miserable, desperate, angry people. To these folks, the system is a disaster. America is the land of "Haves" and "Have Nots." Some have absurd abundance. Some have nothing. And the rate at which things change in favor of the rich versus the poor is only speeding up, not slowing down.

"This rift between the rich and poor is already large... and it is only going to get larger. Mind-blowing changes are coming over the next 10 years, we will see the world change more rapidly than any generation in history. The way we work, travel, bank, receive healthcare, and entertain ourselves will look completely different than they do now. Large new industries will be created at a pace we have never seen before. They will demolish old industries even faster. And it is all because of exponential progress.

"This incredible exponential force explains why some companies are growing so quickly, gobbling up market share, and making more money faster than ever before... and why others are getting utterly demolished at the same incredible rate. I would like to say this strange new era will end soon... but I believe it is just getting started."

The debasement of the U.S. Dollar has reached a dangerous level. By 2028, these generations are scheduled to be the largest voting bloc in the <u>U.S.</u> Once they take the majority... you can bet your bottom dollar that anyone promising less government, less handouts, and less benefits will never see the White House again.

These voters will prefer Gavin Newsom's socialist policies... They will want everything that costs money for free... Anything-goes social policies...

But unbelievably, there may be something more dangerous than Donald Trump that the Democrats should concern themselves with.

Who is John Galt?

In Ayn Rand's 1957 controversial, recognized masterpiece *Atlas Shrugged*, between the surreal descriptions of a world fading into socialism to the incredible

character development of larger than life entrepreneurs, philosophers, and artists, this book is a monument to reason and has arguably never been more relevant than today.



Who is John Galt?

Rand sets out to provide a moral defense of capitalism and demonstrate through the novel's action what happens when governments follow socialist ideas. She argues that when men are compelled, through collectivism's forced moral code, to place the needs of their neighbors above their own rational self-interest, the result is chaos and evil. Incentive is destroyed, and corruption becomes inevitable. For Rand, any economic or political plan based on sacrifice of the individual for the group leads to chaos and destruction.

John Galt represents the main theme of the novel and of Rand's Objectivism philosophy: the idea that the mind is the only means by which man can achieve prosperity. The mind is the motive power that drives civilization, just as the motor Galt develops in the novel can drive industry. Galt embodies the mind, and the question "Who is John Galt?" is not only a literal question about the mysterious man who has disappeared, but a figurative question as well. The question asks *what is the mind?* and *what happens when the mind disappears?* Galt knows that without his mind and the minds of the world's great thinkers, the motive power of the world will be lost, and the motor of the world will stop.

So, if you saw Atlas with his buckling arms trembling but still trying to hold up the world on his shoulders, what would you advise him to do? Galt would advise him to simply shrug...And Atlas Shrugged.

Prometheus was a figure from Greek mythology. He was a titan who stole fire from the gods and brought it to men to improve their lives. In return, he was chained to a rock and tortured. Vultures ate his liver each day, only to have it grow back at night to be eaten again. Prometheus (personified by Galt) represents the great industrialists who have provided men with prosperity and improved their lives with their inventions and products but have received only condemnation and government interference in return. These men, led by Galt, have disappeared, and taken their prosperity-generating minds (the "fire" they had provided) with them. They will no longer allow themselves to receive torture as payment for their talents and gifts, and they will only return their talents to the world when they are no longer punished for bringing them.

John Galt is Prometheus who changed his mind. After centuries of being torn by vultures in payment for having brought to men the fire of the gods, he broke his chains—and he withdrew his fire—until the day when men withdraw their vultures.

In the strike that Galt conceives, organizes, and conducts is the book's central, defining event. But his identity remains a mystery until two-thirds of the way through the novel, lending him a mythical stature. In Galt, Rand has set out to present man in his most ideal form. She describes him as physically beautiful, profoundly brilliant, and enormously accomplished. Not only has he been able to develop a revolutionary motor, but he has also created a philosophy of reason and become a statesman capable of leading the world's most talented men and women. Most importantly, Galt is unwaveringly rational and deals directly with the objective facts he encounters. In him, rationality and emotion are fully integrated. Though ruled by reason, he is able to express and experience his emotions as well.

In the novel, the government proclaims that "for the common good" all copyrights, patents, and trademarks will be transferred to the federal government. All wages and further sources of income for the individual are hereby frozen. This is ordered "to protect the security of our fellow citizens."

The "strike of the mind" led by John Galt demonstrates this central theme of the novel. When the best creative minds are systematically removed from the world, their importance is laid bare. Without the great thinkers, society spirals quickly downward. The economy collapses, and irrational looters seize power. Rand's belief in the central importance of the mind opposes the prevailing wisdom that labor is responsible for prosperity. As the events of the novel show, the mind enables creation and innovation and powers the engine of the world. Labor alone cannot achieve productivity and prosperity without the guidance of the great minds.

Imagine instead of Rand's main character, John Galt, and his fellow titans of industry, Dagny Taggart, Francisco d'Anconia, Ellis Wyatt, and Hank Rearden disappearing from the world one at a time and going on strike leading the revolution of the mind, it was Elon Musk, Jeff Bezos, Larry Ellison, Taylor Swift, and Bill Gates.

Suppose Donald Trump lost his properties and wealth due to prosecutions and excessive bonds and decided not to subject himself to this punishment, but in fact to withdraw himself from society and convincing his fellow modern titans of industry to join him to go on strike.

Atlas Shrugged furthers the theme of individualism that Ayn Rand developed in *The Fountainhead*. In *The Fountainhead*, she shows by means of its hero, the innovative architect Howard Roark, that the independent mind is responsible for all human progress and prosperity. In *Atlas Shrugged*, she shows that without the independent mind, our society would collapse into primitive savagery. *Atlas Shrugged* is an impassioned defense of the freedom of man's mind. But to understand the author's sense of urgency, we must have an idea of the context in which the book was written. This includes both the post-World War II Cold War and the broader trends of modern intellectual culture.

Twentieth-century culture spawned the most oppressive dictatorships in human history. The Fascists in Italy, the National Socialists (Nazis) in Germany, and the Communists — first in Russia and later in China and elsewhere — seriously threatened individual freedom throughout the world. Ayn Rand lived through the heart of this terrifying historical period. In fact, when she started writing *Atlas Shrugged* in 1946, the West had just achieved victory over the Nazis. For years, the specter of national socialism had haunted the world, exterminating millions of innocent people, enslaving millions more, and threatening the freedom of the entire globe. The triumph of the free countries of the West over Naziism was achieved at an enormous cost in human life. However, it left the threat of communism unabated.

In 1956 when Ayn Rand was writing *Atlas Shrugged*, many Americans strongly believed that the government should have the power to coercively redistribute income and to regulate private industry. The capitalist system of political and economic freedom was consistently attacked by socialists and welfare statists. The belief that an individual has a right to live his own life was replaced, to a significant extent, by the collectivist idea that individuals must work and live in

service to other people. Individual rights and political freedom were threatened in American politics, education, and culture.

Can you believe this? I read today on my iPhone notifications that 28% of the housing in France today is government ordered to eventually make room available for everyone. Are we watching the movie *Dr. Zhivago* play out here?

Rand further argues in *Atlas Shrugged* that the freedom of American society is responsible for its greatest achievements. For example, in the nineteenth century, inventors and entrepreneurs created an outpouring of innovations that raised the standard of living to unprecedented heights and changed forever the way people live. Rand, who thoroughly researched the history of capitalism, was well aware of the progress made during this period of economic freedom. Samuel Morse invented the telegraph — a device later improved by Thomas Edison, who went on to invent the phonograph, the electric light, and the motion picture projector. John Roebling perfected the suspension bridge and, just before his death, designed his masterpiece, the Brooklyn Bridge. Henry Ford revolutionized the transportation industry by mass-producing automobiles, a revolution that the Wright Brothers carried to the next level with their invention of the airplane. Railroad builders like Cornelius Vanderbilt and James J. Hill established inexpensive modes of transportation and opened up the Pacific Northwest to economic development.

Likewise, Alexander Graham Bell invented the telephone during this era, Cyrus McCormick the reaper, and Elias Howe the sewing machine. Charles Goodyear discovered the vulcanization process that made rubber useful, and George Eastman revolutionized photography with the invention of a new type of camera — the Kodak. George Washington Carver, among myriad agricultural accomplishments, developed peanuts and sweet potatoes into leading crops. Architects like Louis Sullivan and William LeBaron Jenney created the skyscraper, and George Westinghouse, the inventor of train airbrakes, developed a power system able to transmit electricity over great distances. The penniless Scottish immigrant Andrew Carnegie built a vast company manufacturing steel, and John D. Rockefeller did the same in the oil industry.

These are but a few examples from an exhaustive list of advances in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Ayn Rand argues that economic freedom liberated these great creative thinkers, permitting them to put into practice new ideas and methods. But what would happen if economic freedom were lost?

Atlas Shrugged provides Ayn Rand's answer to this question. In the story, she projects the culmination of America's twentieth-century socialist trend. The U.S. government portrayed in the story has significant control over the domestic economy. The rest of the world has been swallowed up by communist "Peoples' States" and subsists in abject poverty. A limited degree of economic freedom still exists in America, but it is steadily declining, as is American prosperity.

The successful are heavily taxed to support the poor, and the American poor are similarly levied to finance the even poorer people in foreign Peoples' States. The government subsidizes inefficient businesses at the expense of the more efficient.

With the state controlling large portions of the economy, the result is the rise of corrupt businessmen who seek profit by manipulating crooked politicians rather than by doing productive work. The government forces inventors to give up their patents so that all manufacturers may benefit equally from new products. Similarly, the government breaks up productive companies, compelling them to share the market with weaker (less efficient) competitors. In short, the fictionalized universe of *Atlas Shrugged* presents a future in which the U.S. trend toward socialism has been accelerated. Twentieth-century realities such as heavy taxation, massive social welfare programs, tight governmental regulation of industry, and antitrust action against successful companies are heightened in the universe of this story.

The government annuls the rights of American citizens, and freedom is steadily eroded. The United States of the novel — the last bastion of liberty on earth — rapidly becomes a communist dictatorship.

The result, in Rand's fictional universe, is a collapse of American prosperity. Great minds are shackled by government policies, and their innovations are either rejected or expropriated by the state. Thinkers lack the freedom necessary to create new products, to start their own companies, to compete openly, and to earn wealth. Under the increasing yoke of tyranny, the most independent minds in American society choose to defend their liberty in the most effective manner possible: They withdraw from society.

In this scenario we would not have today the minds we do have and their creations... Elon Musk – The Tesla electric car, and Space X. Jeff Bezos – Amazon. Bill Gates – Microsoft. Mark Zuckerberg – Facebook/Meta. And yes, even Taylor Swift and her music and performances.

Atlas Shrugged in essence is a novel about a strike. Ayn Rand sets out to show the fate that befalls the world when the thinkers and creators go on strike. The author

raises an intriguing question: What would happen if the scientists, medical researchers, inventors, industrialists, writers, artists, and so on withheld their minds and their achievements from the world?

Rand argues that all human progress and prosperity depend on rational thinking. For example, human beings have cured such diseases as malaria, polio, dysentery, cholera, diphtheria, and tuberculosis. Man has learned to fly, erect cities and skyscrapers, grow an abundant food supply, and create computers. Humans have been to the moon and back and have invented the telephone, radio, television, and a thousand other life-promoting technologies. All of these achievements result from the human application of a rational mind to practical questions of survival. If the intellectuals responsible for such advances abandon the world, regression to the primitive conditions of the Dark Ages would result. But what would motivate intellectuals to such an extreme act as going on strike? We are used to hearing about strikes, that protest conditions considered oppressive or intolerable by workers. The thinkers go on strike in *Atlas Shrugged* to protest the oppression of their intellect and creativity.

The thinkers in *Atlas Shrugged* strike on behalf of individual rights and political freedom. They strike against an enforced moral code of self-sacrifice — the creed that human life must be devoted to serving the needs of others. Above all, the thinkers strike to prove that reason is the only means by which man can understand reality and make proper decisions; emotions should not guide human behavior. In short, the creative minds are on strike in support of a person's right to think and live independently.

Withdrawal of the great thinkers causes the collapse of the American economy and the end of dictatorship. The strike proves the role that the rational mind plays in the attainment of progress and prosperity.

The emphasis on reason is the hallmark of Ayn Rand's fiction. All of her novels, in one form or another, glorify the life-giving power of the human mind.

For example, in *The Fountainhead*, Ayn Rand emphasizes the independent nature of the mind's functioning — that rational individuals neither conform to society nor obey authority but trust their own judgment. In her early novelette *Anthem*, Ayn Rand shows that under a collectivist dictatorship, the mind is stifled and society regresses to a condition of primitive ignorance. *Anthem* focuses on the mind's need for political freedom. The focus of *Atlas Shrugged* is the role that the human mind plays in human existence. *Atlas Shrugged* shows that rational thinking is mankind's

survival instrument, just as the ability to fly is the survival tool for birds. In all of her major novels, Ayn Rand presents heroes and heroines who are brilliant thinkers opposed to either society's pressure to conform or a dictatorial government's commands to obey. The common denominator in all of her books is the life-and-death importance, for both the individual and society, of remaining true to the mind.

In *Atlas Shrugged*, Ayn Rand presents, for the first time and in a dramatized form, her original philosophy of Objectivism. She exemplifies this philosophy in the lives of the heroes and in the action of the story. *Objectivism* holds that reason — not faith or emotionalism — is man's sole means of gaining knowledge. Her theory states that an individual has a right to his or her own life and to the pursuit of his or her own happiness, which is counter to the view that man should sacrifice himself to society.

Objectivism is individualistic, holding that the purpose of government is to protect the sovereign rights of an individual. This philosophy opposes the collectivist notion that society as a whole is superior to the individual, who must subordinate himself to its requirements. In the political/economic realm, Objectivism upholds full laissez-faire capitalism — a system of free markets that legally prevent the government from restricting man's productive activities — as the only philosophical system that protects the freedom of man's mind, the rights of the individual, and the prosperity of man's life on earth.

Because of Ayn Rand's uncompromising defense of the mind, of the individual, and of capitalism, *Atlas Shrugged* created great controversy on its publication in 1957. Denounced by critics and intellectuals, the book nevertheless reached a wide audience. The book has sold millions of copies and influenced the lives of countless readers. Since 1957, Ayn Rand's philosophy of Objectivism has gradually taken hold in American society.

In the novel, just as the head of state prepares to give a speech on the economic situation, John Galt takes over the airwaves and delivers a lengthy address to the country, laying out the terms of the strike he has organized. In desperation, the government seeks Galt to make him their economic dictator. Dagny inadvertently leads them to him, and they take him prisoner. But Galt refuses to help them, even after he is tortured. Finally, Dagny and the strikers rescue him in an armed confrontation with guards. They return to the valley, where Dagny finally joins the strike. Soon, the country's collapse is complete, and the strikers prepare to return.

The book's opening line, "Who is John Galt?", is an expression of helplessness and despair at the current state of the novel's fictionalized world. The book's protagonist, Dagny Taggart, hears a number of legends of Galt before finding him. In one legend Galt seeks the lost island of Atlantis, in another he discovers the Fountain of Youth. After eventually joining Galt's cause and falling in love with him, Taggart learns that all of the stories metaphorically speaking have an element of truth to them. Finally, when asked "Who is John Galt?", she replies "We are!"

V. The Epicenter - California's 32nd Congressional District
